Explore techniques to use to paint the weather

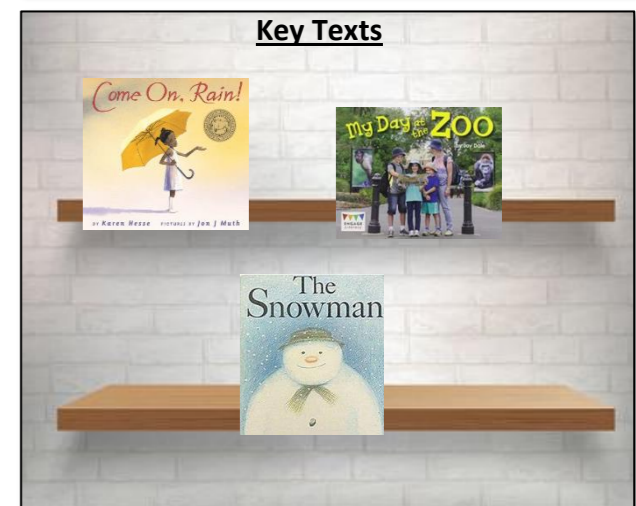
